- How to safely guide a person with a visual impairment
- Appropriate language and effective communication
- Reasonable adjustments in compliance with the Equality Act 2010
- The importance of eye health care
- How the built environment can enable or disable people.

- How do I support a visually impaired person?
- Will they be offended if I use visual language such as “see you later”?
- How do I guide someone with sight loss?
- How can I ensure my business is accessible for people with sight loss?
- What adjustments do I need to put in place for a person with a visual impairment?
