## Are you a UK taxpayer?

Gift Aid is reclaimed by RNIB from the tax you pay for the current tax year. Your home address is needed to identify you as a current UK taxpayer.

In order to Gift Aid your donation you must tick the box below:

I am a UK taxpayer and understand that if I pay less Income Tax and/or Capital Gains Tax than the amount of Gift Aid claimed on all my donations in that tax year it is my responsibility to pay any difference.

You can cancel this declaration at any time. Please notify RNIB if you no longer pay enough Income Tax and/or Capital Gains Tax to cover the amount claimed by RNIB, or if you change your name or address.

If you pay income tax at the higher or additional rate and want to receive the additional tax relief due to you, you must include all your Gift Aid donations on your Self-Assessment tax return or ask HM Revenue and Customs to adjust your tax code.
